to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James A. Boling, his heirs and assigns forever:

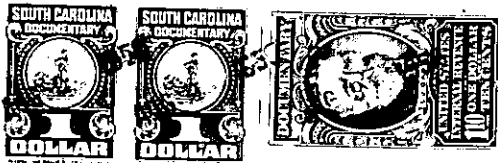
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southeastern side of Barbara Avenue, being shown and designated as lot # 282 as shown on a plat of the property of Robert J. Edwards, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at Page 61, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Barbara Avenue, joint front corner of lots # 282 and 281, and running thence with the line of lot # 281, S. 47 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 43 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of lot # 283; thence with the line of lot # 283, N. 47 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on Barbara Avenue; thence with the Southeastern side of Barbara Avenue, N. 43 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

It is understood that this conveyance is made subject to restrictive covenants recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 505 at Page 291.

Robert J. Edwards died in estate March 26, 1956, leaving as his sole heirs at law the Grantors herein.
