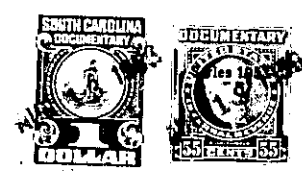

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, B.J. Arledge, Grantor, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Raywood Dill, Grantee, and his heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain tract of land in said State and County, O'Neal Township, near Milford Baptist Church, and lying on the North side of Milford-Double Springs Road (also known as the Licklehaney Road), and being bounded on the North by lands of Cope Campbell, on the East by lands of Lloyd R. Plumley just conveyed to him this day by Grantor herein, on the South by said Road and on the West by other lands of Grantee herein, and being the western half of that certain tract of land conveyed to me by W.A. Clark by deed recorded in the Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book Vol. 374 at page 445, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING at a stake in the center of said Road, joint front corner of Lloyd R. Plumley's land conveyed to him this day by Grantor herein, and this tract of land, and runs thence with the Plumley line N. 14-45 W. 1036½ feet, more or less, to a stake, new corner, on Cope Campbell's line; thence therewith S. 86-45 E. 104.1 feet to rear corner of other land of Grantee herein; thence with the line of Grantee's other land S. 14-45 E. 1034 feet to point in center of said Road, front corner of Grantee's other land; thence with said Road N. 87-35 E. 105 feet to the beginning corner.
