ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as LOT NO. 12 as shown on plat of property known as SUNNYMEDE according to a Survey made by Woodward Engineering Company, March 1955 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "EE", at page 85, and also shown in Plat Book II, at page 109 and being shown on the County Block Book at 108-1-28 and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 12 and 13 on Chestnut Street and running thence S. 19-02 W. 245.7 feet to a pin on Brushy Creek; running thence S. 73-25 E. 68.8 feet to a pin; thence N. 20-47 E. 248.2 feet to an iron pin; running thence along Chestnut Street, N. 71-30 W. 61.1 feet to the point of beginning. The distances described herein are from pin to pin as shown on said plat, but all lots extend to the center of Brushy Creek.

This property is sold subject to the right of way granted the Duke Power Company and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 310, at page 232 and is subject to all other easements, rights-of-way and restrictions recorded against said subdivision in the RMC Office for Greenville County.
