

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF

GRACELAND CEMETERY DEVELOPMENT CO., INC.

1. RULES GOVERNING CEMETERY LOT OWNERSHIP. Lots purchased in Graceland Cemetery are conveyed by Warranty Deed to the purchaser for his family and heirs as a burial place forever.

In order that the Corporation may have a correct record of ownership of lots which are to be conveyed to others, it is required that the recorded deed shall be presented to the office so that a record of transfer can be made. A fee of \$2.00 will be collected before any transfer of ownership is made on the Corporation's records. The Corporation is governed by its own records as to ownership of lots.

When a lot is purchased and an extension of time is granted by the Corporation for payment, the Corporation retains ownership of the lot until all charges due it are paid, and the Corporation reserves the right to remove the remains which may be interred on the lot, to a smaller lot equal in value to the amount paid on the original lot, or to a smaller grave in the event that a default occurs in the agreed payment.

An order in writing is required of the lot owner when a grave is to be opened, containing the name, age, sex and residence of the deceased, and a permit from the Board of Health must be shown the Superintendent of the grounds before interment is made. If interment is to be made in the forenoon, application must be made before 2 o'clock p. m. on the previous day. If in the afternoon, by 9 o'clock a. m. on the same day.

Lot owners shall at once notify the Corporation of any change in his or her post office address or name.

No interment shall be allowed except upon order of the Executive Officers of the Corporation, and upon the written order of the owner or owners of the lot, and in every case can only be made under the supervision of the Superintendent.

The Corporation shall have the right at all times to enter upon each and every lot for the purpose of maintaining, cleaning and polishing it.

The Corporation from time to time may lay out or alter such avenues or walks, or make such repairs and regulations for the government of the grounds as it may in its wisdom or in order to promote the general objects of the cemetery.

No contract or approval of the Corporation shall be valid or binding unless the same shall be in writing over the signature of an Executive Officer.

5. RULES GOVERNING WORK DONE AT CEMETERY. All orders for work should be left with the Superintendent who is located on the Cemetery property. Work orders are forbidden to accept orders for work or to be allowed to accept fees, payments of any sort, or to receive any other consideration.

No lot owner shall have the right to have shrubs and plants set out on any part of the lot except upon order of the Corporation. In the event of persons who are allowed to have shrubs and plants set out on the lot, the Corporation shall have the right to remove them at any time if they are found to be in violation of the rules. No lot owner shall be allowed to have any other plants or shrubs set out on the lot without the approval of the Corporation. No work shall be permitted on any lot or monument.

to put any covering such as enamel, stone or foreign substance on any grave or lot. No erasing or cutting of markings, brasses or inscriptions can be used except upon order of the Superintendent. No sign indicating a lot or vault is to be placed on the lot or in the cemetery grounds.

No improvement shall be made on monument, effigy, or structure of any kind on or adjacent to any lot without the consent of the Corporation.

No work of any character will be done upon any lot except by contract with the Corporation, or by some person authorized in its behalf, and no lawns, trees, shrubs, vines, flowers, ferns, or excelsior shall be placed on or dug upon any lot except by the Cemetery employees as directed by the Superintendent.

The grade of all lots, lawns, and avenues as established, or changed, from time to time, by the Corporation and all improvements put or placed upon any lot shall not be altered or changed except by the Corporation.

No trees, shrubs, or plants shall be placed upon or removed from any lot or planted, except with the consent of the Corporation, but the Corporation shall have the right, from time to time, to plant, transplant, remove, or trim trees, shrubs, and plants upon said lots.

The Corporation reserves to itself the entire control of every tree, shrub, or vine growing within the cemetery enclosure, whether planted by the lot owner or otherwise, including the right of removal when it comes to its removal advisable.

Trees will not be removed to make additional burial space.

The Corporation will use reasonable care in examining trees and removing those apparently in unsound and dangerous condition or unsound and dangerous limbs and branches of trees, but it expressly disclaims responsibility for damage either to persons or property in such cases from falling trees or parts of trees.

No flowers or ornaments or objects shall be kept upon any lot after the same shall have become withered, soiled or unsightly and in case of the failure of the owner of any lot to remove any such flowers or other unsightly objects the Corporation shall have the right to remove the same and in no case will the Corporation attempt to find fault with or remove any lot or monument or structure placed on the lot or grave.

No back-slash, cross, or any other metal arches, water pipes, glass cases, covering, or any other artificial flows, or any sort of structure for flowers, except such as may be placed below the surface of the lawn for the grave or lot containing a casket or other object which may be lifted out while moving the said lot, shall be placed on any grave or lot and all such structures not so placed below the surface of the lawn, grass, or lot, may be removed by the Corporation.

6. RULES FOR VISITORS AT THE CEMETERY. The cemetery will be open from seven o'clock a. m. to seven p. m.

No persons, refreshments, or other articles, for any purpose, shall be brought into the cemetery, and no person shall be allowed to have a dog or other animal on the premises. No person shall be allowed to have a horse or other animal on the premises. No person shall be allowed to have a horse or other animal on the premises.

The roads and walks which are the property of the Corporation are to be used as a means of access to the lots and monuments on the cemetery. No person shall be allowed to use the roads and walks for any other purpose.

All persons who are allowed to enter the cemetery shall be required to keep to the right and to give way to all persons who are proceeding in the same direction.
