HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Robert Edward Campbell and Jean R. Campbell

All that certain lot of land situated in Chick Springs Township,
County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as lot No. 45 in
what is known as Woodland Heights, property of the I. M. Wood Estate as
shown on a subdivision and plat of same made by H. S. Brockman, Reg.
Surveyor, dated October 28, 1955, said plat being of record in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, page 151 and
having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances as shown
by said plat, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the southern boundary of Bessie Avenue,
joint front corner of lots 44 and 45, and running thence along said avenue
N. 45-18 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot No. 46; thence S.
39-15 E. 190 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of lots 25, 26,
45 and 46; thence S. 45-18 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear
corner of lots 26, 27, 44 and 45; thence N. 39-15 W. 190 feet to an iron
