Know All Men by These Presents:

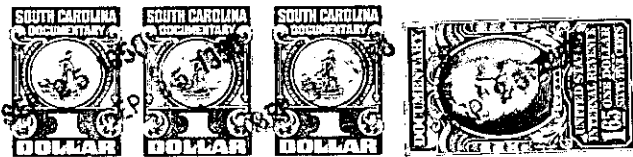

WESTMORELAND and FRANCES S. WESTMORELAND, their heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, near Paris School District, about five (5) miles North of the City of Greenville and on the West side of Rutherford Road and North side of Park Avenue and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Park Avenue and Rutherford Road, and running thence N. 74-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18-15 E. 95 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74-30 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Rutherford Road; thence S. 15-30 W. 95 feet to beginning corner, designated as Lot No. 107 on plat prepared by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor, May 1944, and bounded on the South by Park Avenue, on the West by other lands of M. C. Green, on the North by Lot No. 106 and on the East by Rutherford Road, said plat being hereby referred to for further aid in the description of said boundary.
