EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, WILLIAM B. PRICE, WILLIAM S. REYNER and EARLE M. GLAZENER
all of
Greenville, South Carolina

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of
CIVITAN CLUB OF GREENVILLE, S. C.
(Greenville, S. C.)

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 27th. day of
September, A. D. 1956, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville-Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is THE CIVITAN CLUB OF GREENVILLE, S. C.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to hold a charter under the rules and regulations prescribed in the Constitution and By-Laws of Civitan International; to meet together regularly in an atmosphere of normal fellowship for the purpose of acquiring a broader knowledge of public affairs and community needs and through instruction, discussion and study to become better prepared for intelligent leadership and cooperation in solving civic problems and to seek through the meetings opportunities to express activities of altruistic and civic character the fruits of mutual contact and study; to promote the welfare of mankind by works of charity and advance the common good in any form or manner; to accept and receive contributions and/or gifts or grants in cash, personal property or other property for charitable or eleemosynary purposes or uses; to expend funds and to use, give or disburse funds, personal property or property for charitable or eleemosynary uses and purposes; to own, lease, construct, maintain and/or operate a fresh air camp or camps for underprivileged children and/or for physically or mentally handicapped children; to produce or present or sponsor or promote theatricals, dramas, ice shows, athletic events or contests and/or any other form of entertainment using the net proceeds thereof, after the payment of all expenses, for charitable or eleemosynary purposes or uses; to sell merchandise and/or other goods or chattels using the net proceeds of such sales, after the payment of all expenses, for charitable or eleemosynary purposes and uses; and to build Good Citizenship through charitable or eleemosynary acts, deeds and works.
