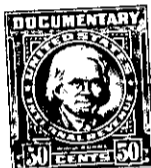

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, heretofore Mark Bell, George Bell and Buford Bell executed and delivered to R. W. Bell a deed conveying their interest in the lands hereinafter described; and whereas, said deed was acknowledged before W. M. Guest, Notary Public for South Carolina, who failed to properly notarize the same, and the parties hereto are desirous of correcting said mistake and executing this deed in conformity with the law of South Carolina and North Carolina, in order that the grantee shall receive an indefeasible, fee simple title to said land;

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INDENTURE

For True Consideration Hereinset  
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WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of (\$ 10.00) Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS, in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Bargained and Sold, Conveyed and Confirmed, and by these presents do Bargain and Sell and Convey and Confirm, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described piece or parcel of land lying and being in the Township of Green River, County of Henderson, and State of North Carolina, and known and designated as follows, and in the Township of Saluda, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and known and designated as follows, viz:

The land herein referred to lies partly in Green River Township, Henderson County, North Carolina, and partly in Saluda Township, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and is all the land owned by J. M. Bell at the time of his death in said counties and townships and is more particularly described, as follows:

All of my undivided interest in a certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being partly in the County of Greenville and in the State aforesaid, and part in Henderson County, North Carolina, and is my prorata share as one of the heirs in the land owned by J. M. Bell at the time of his death and is on head waters of Fall Creek, head waters of North Saluda River and on head waters of Pacolet River and bounded by lands of R. P. Ward, R. W. I. Pace, and others, and contains 230 acres, more or less.
