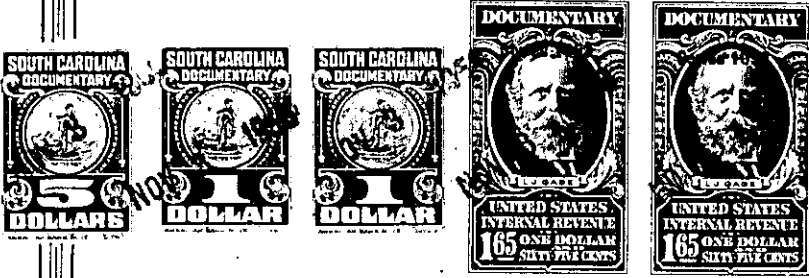

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the settlement road and Hunts Bridge
Road S. E. 41⁰ for a distance of 5.13 Chains to a N. M. then N. 16⁰: 30'E
for a distance of 4.20 Chains to a N. M. thence S. West 80⁰ to O. M. Thence
N. W. 88⁰ to O. M. at the intersection of the settlement road and Hunts Bridge
Road at the beginning, a distance of 4.66 Chains, containing .78 of an acre
according to plat-D. B. Hunt.
