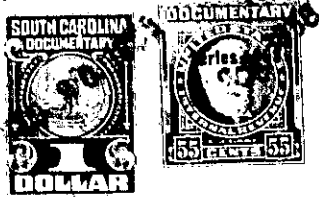

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, F. W. Fowler, Bertha Fowler Vaughn, M. F. Fowler, F. M. Fowler and Raymond Fowler, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and no/100 (\$500.00) Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Ethel Fowler Collins (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ethel Fowler Collins, her heirs and assigns:

~~all that piece, parcel or lot of land in~~ Township,
~~County, State of South Carolina~~

All of our right, title and undivided interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in Standing Springs Road, F. W. Fowler corner, and running N. 76 1/2 W., 3.16 to an iron pin; thence S. 10 W., 2.61 to an iron pin in road; thence S. 70 E., 4.33 to pin in forks of road; thence N. 17 W., 2.64 to an iron pin; thence N. 10 E., .79 links to the beginning corner.

Less, however, a lot of land containing .40 acres heretofore conveyed by F. W. Fowler to Fuller M. Fowler on September 27, 1952, which deed is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County and State aforesaid in Vol. 463, page 476, and less .23 acres heretofore conveyed by F. W. Fowler to R. P. Fowler on August 18, 1954, which deed is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County and State aforesaid in Vol. 507 at page 242.
