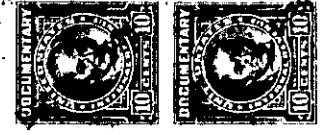

in the State aforesaid,

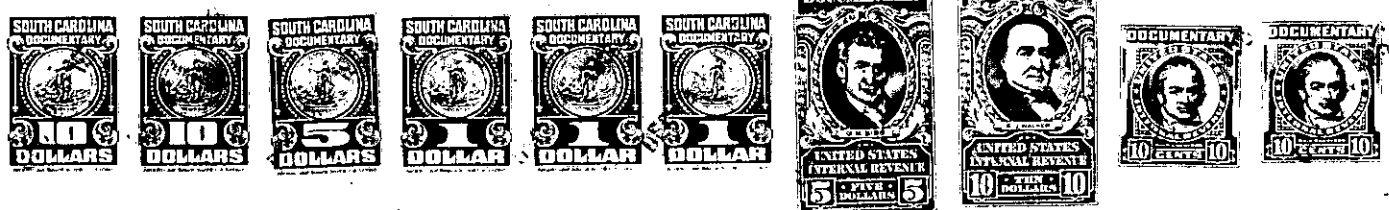

STUART C. PETERSON AND ANNE W. PETERSON:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 5, Block A, as shown on a plat of Brookforest prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book BB at pages 40 and 41, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Woodmont Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 4 N. 11-46 W. 189.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 68-26 W. 71.1 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence with the line of Lot No. 6 S. 11-46 E. 177.4 feet to an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Woodmont Circle; thence with the Northwestern side of Woodmont Circle N. 78-16 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Stuart C. Peterson and Anne Williams Peterson by deed dated August 30, 1956, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 560 at page 397.
