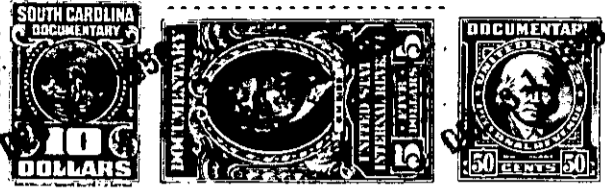

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William H. Wood _____

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in School District 6 E ~~Township~~
County, State of South Carolina Located at intersection of the Easley Bridge Road
and Washington Avenue, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING, at an iron pin at the intersection of Easley Bridge Road, and
Washington Avenue and running thence along the North side of the Easley Bridge
Road S. 70-56 *N.* 46 feet to an iron pin, corner of property now or formerly of
F.B. Pinson; thence with the line of the Pinson property N. 20-38 *N.* 128.5 feet
to an iron pin on line of property now or formerly of Vordin; thence with the line
of the Verdin property N. 63-E 43 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the West
side of Washington Avenue; thence with the west side of Washington Avenue
S. 22-E 130.7 feet to the beginning corner and being a portion of the property
conveyed by Irvin H. Philpot by deed dated June 16, 1947, and recorded in the
R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 314, Page 77.
