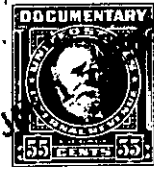

J. Frank Williams, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land lying, situate
and being in the State and County aforesaid, in subdivision known as
"Riverside", and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 of Block "K"
according to plat of said subdivision made by Carter and Pringle,
Surveyors, said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville
County, S. C., said lot having a frontage on Palmetto Avenue of 50 feet
and a depth of 125 feet to an alley, and being the same lot of land
conveyed to Marion Brawley by W. E. Razor by deed dated March 18, 1926,
and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in
Deed Book 106, at page 466. Marion Brawley died testate, a resident
of Greenville County, S. C., on June 20, 1956, his will and the record
