(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the saidAnsel Alewine, his heirs and
assigns, forever:

ALL my right, title and interest, consisting of an undivided one-third in-
terest, in and to all those pieces, parcels or tracts of land, containing
in the aggregate a tract of 10.78 acres, more or less, on the branch waters
of Enoree River, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina,
being all of the land of which my late father, Belt Greer, was seized and
possessed at the time of his death, said tract or tracts being more part-
icularly described, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stone 3XOM on land formerly owned by Green Ingram and running
thence with said Green Ingram's line, S. 62-3/4 W. 8.40 chains to a stone
3XOM: thence S. 50 1/4 E. 14.40 chains to a stone 3XNM in the bottoms; thence
N. 40-E. 7.60 chains to a stone 3XNM on the line of property formerly owned
by Mary Priestly; thence N. 48 1/3 W. 10.50 chains to the point of beginning,
bounded by lands formerly owned by Green Ingram, Sarah E. Greer, Nancy E.
Lewis and Mary Priestly. The said above described tract is the same con-
veyed to Telitha A. Stall by Nancy E. Lewis and Sarah E. Greer on Novwmber
13, 1885 by deed recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South
Carolina, in Deed Book YY, page 23.

The said deceased Belt Greer acquired the entire above described tract in
parcels as follows: 2.78 acres by deed of Samuel Stall, dated October 19,
1929, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in
Deed Book 134, page 476; 5 acres, more or less, as a devisee under the will
of Samuel Stall, who died December 10, 1931, said will being on file in
the Office of the Judge of Probate for Greenville County, South Carolina, in
Apartment 276, File 8; the residue or remainder of the said Telitha A.
Stall tract, consisting of 3 acres, more or less, by deed of Margie Walker,
J. Van Jackson, Sammie Mayfield, sole heirs of Sam Stall, deceased, dated
December 7, 1942, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South
Carolina in Deed Book 251, page 55.

The said Belt Greer on April 2, 1946 died seized and possessed of the above
tract or tracts, survived by his widow, Lenna (or Linia) Greer, his son,
Sam Lewis Greer, and the children of his deceased daughter, Ella Bee Jackson,
who died in February, 1931, said children being Albertus Jackson and Clinton
Jackson, all of whom are of legal age and sui juris.
