to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Amos Taylor, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 and having 1.63 acres, more or less, according to a plat of property of L. W. Young prepared by C. O. Riddle dated April 1955, recorded in Plat Book II, page 119 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of said road and running thence S. 36 E. 269.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83-24 E. 258.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 6-36 W. 275.2 feet to a point in the center of line of said Piedmont-Bessie Highway; thence along the center of said highway S. 83-24 W. 189.7 feet to a point; thence continuing along the center of said highway S. 78-58 W. 68.9 feet to the point of beginning.
