McNeill, of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) ----- DOLLARS, and correction of Deed dated Jan. 21, 1956, recorded in Vol. 543, page 521, R.M.C. office, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Howard Thomason and Hazel Thomason, their heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, between Pendleton Street and Perry Avenue, being the western portion of lot known and designated as Lot Number One (No. 1), as shown on plat of property of McNeill Brothers, made by Dalton & Neves, Engrs., dated June 1952, recorded in R.M.C. office, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northeast intersection of Queen Street (now N. Textile Street) and Pendleton Street, and running thence with said Pendleton Street, S. 72-15 E. 50 feet to a point; thence N. 22-0 E. 383 1/2 feet, more or less, to a point on southern side of Perry Avenue, which point is Fifty (50) feet easterly from the intersection of Perry Avenue and Queen Street (now N. Textile St.); thence with southern side of said Perry Avenue, N. 68-08 W. 50 feet to a point, iron pin, on the eastern side of Queen Street (now N. Textile St.); thence S. 22-0 W. 386 feet along eastern side of Queen Street (now N. Textile St.), to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is executed subject to any and all recorded and existing Restrictions, Agreements, Rights of Way and Easements.

It is understood and agreed, by and between Grantor and Grantees herein, that only a maximum of Forty Four Hundred Two and 66/100 (4402.66) square feet of ground building area shall be used for building purposes on above described property, unless otherwise mutually agreed to in writing by and between the Grantor, his heirs and assigns, and Grantees, their heirs and assigns.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
