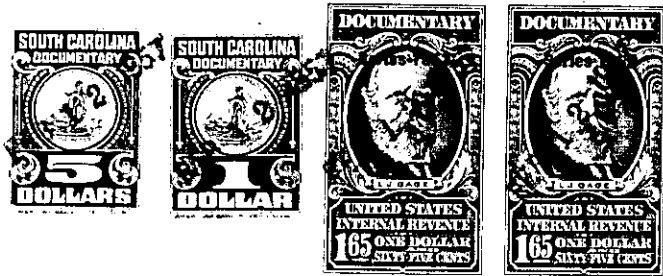

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, DORIS S. SMITH
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Marshall E. Wolfe and wife,
Betty Black Wolfe, their heirs and assigns, forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina :

BEGINNING at an old stone corner which is South 36° 5 min. West 70' to
an iron pin in the center of Barton Road and runs thence South 41°
41 min. West 70' to a stake; thence North 41° 30 min. West 200' to
a stake; thence North 53° 25 min. East 200' to a point in the center
of Barton Road; thence with the center of Barton Road South 20° 10
min. East 260' to the iron pin first above mentioned; thence South
36° 5 min. West 63' to the point of BEGINNING, containing one acre,
more or less.
