BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

WHEREAS, WILLIAM T. WALKER and J. H. WALKER

did on the 12th. day of February, 1957, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is PROFESSIONAL PHARMACY OF GREER

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greer, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to maintain and operate a general retail and wholesale drugstore; to buy, sell and generally deal in at wholesale and retail, all drugs, medicines, toilet and fancy articles and goods, druggists' sundries, soaps, perfumes, surgical instruments, appliances and apparatus, physicians and hospital supplies, pharmaceutical and other goods and articles pertaining to the drug business; to fill prescriptions; to operate soda fountains, sell ice cream and other refreshments; to buy, sell and deal in cigars, cigarettes, tobacco, candies, toilet articles and all other articles incident to the drug business, and generally to have and exercise all of the powers, rights and privileges conferred by the laws of the State of South Carolina upon corporations organized thereunder.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) ----- Dollars payable 20% cash, balance at call of Directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Five Hundred (500) of the par value of Fifty (\$50.00) ----- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 11th. day of February, 1957, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: William T. Walker, J. H. Walker and Eulalia I. Walker

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, William T. Walker ;  
as Vice-President, J. H. Walker ; as Secretary, Eulalia I. Walker ;  
as Treasurer, William T. Walker as Asst. Treas. Eulalia I. Walker

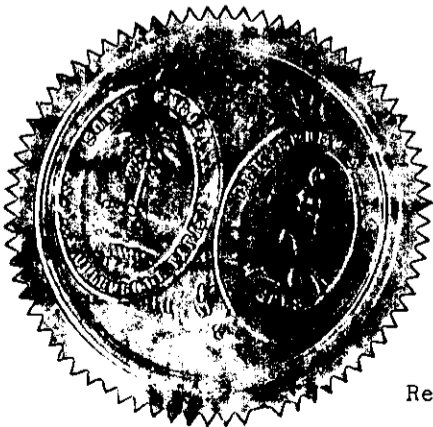
NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
