Whereas, it appears to the satisfaction of the Commission that the real estate of Ralph Hawkins hereinafter described is subject to a prior mortgage, to the extent of the fair market value thereof; and that the said Ralph Hawkins and his wife are conveying the same to Christ Church (Episcopal) of Greenville, S. C. in consideration of assumption of the mortgage indebtedness, without other consideration;

Now therefore, the South Carolina Employment Security Commission does hereby release and discharge the following described real estate from the aforesaid judgment lien:

"All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the Northwest side of East North Street in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 10 on plat of Isaqueena Park, made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, June 3, 1947, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 'P', pages 130 and 131, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:
