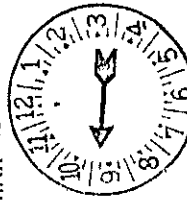

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Greenville County
....., a body politic
and corporate under the laws of the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of
One and No/100 (\$1.00) - - - - - Dollars,
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the
grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto
B. F. Alexander and Edna K. Alexander, their heirs and assigns:

All the right, title and interest of the grantor in and to
the now abandoned portion of the Easley Road extending from
the new right of way to a point on the Southern bank of Saluda
River (this section of said roadway having been abandoned
for public use upon the erection of a new bridge and a connect-
ing approach approximately 265 feet East of the former bridge),
the said roadway being shown on a plat made by Dalton & Neves
in June, 1943, and according to said plat the courses and dis-
tances of such abandoned section are as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southern bank of Saluda
River and running thence S. 32 E. 75 feet to an iron
pin; thence S. 77-10 E. 160 feet to an iron pin; thence
S. 81-31 E. 250 feet to an iron pin at or near the point
of connection with the newly constructed right of way.
