KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That **IMACLYDE E. SATTERFIELD,**

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of **Ten Thousand and No/100ths (\$10,000.00)** ----- DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto **CLYDE J. JONES:**

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the North side of Waverly Court in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 14 and 15 as shown on plat of Augusta Heights made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1941, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K at page 88, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Waverly Court at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14, said pin being 300 feet West from the Northwest corner of the intersection of Waverly Court and Tyler Street and running thence along the line of Lot No. 13 N. 26-38 W. 168.6 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Amherst Avenue; thence with the South side of Amherst Avenue S. 62-20 W. 120 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 16 S. 26-38 E. 168.6 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Waverly Court; thence along the North side of Waverly Court N. 62-20 E. 120 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the identical property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Jacqueline H. Neville and William J. Neville, dated September 13, 1947, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 317 at page 191.
