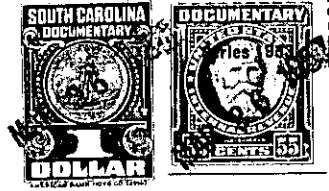

unto the said Clifton A. Stokes

all the right, title and interest of the Defendants, James Everette  
Stokes, Gerald W. Stokes and Celia J. Stokes, in and to the following:

"All of that certain parcel or tract of land containing 46 acres, more  
or less, situated on the west side of the Jordan Road, near Jordan School,  
in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, bounded  
by lands now or formerly belonging to Hilton Babb, J. A. Herman, and others  
and being the same property conveyed to P. J. Stokes by deeds of M.C. Stokes  
Hilton Babb, and J. A. Herman, recorded in Deed Books EEE, Page 488; 20,  
Page 327, and 45, Page 325, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County."
