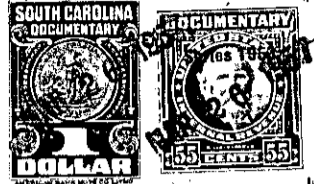

and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County

of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$212.86

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release

unto the said Bertha J. Stokes,
all the right, title and interest of the Defendants, James Everette Stokes,
Gerald W. Stokes and Celia J. Stokes, in and to the following:

"All of that certain parcel or tract of land containing 21 acres, more
of less, situated on the east side of the Jordan Road, near Jordan School,
in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having
the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone on the east side of the Jordan Road, and running
thence N. 74-3/4 E. 17.80 chains to a stone; thence N. 31 W. 8.25 chains
to a stone; thence N. 8.25 chains to a stone; thence N. 69 W. 4.18 chains
to a stone; thence S. 24 W. 16.70 chains to a R. O.; thence W. 2.57 chains
to a stone on the east side of the Jordan Road; thence along said road in
a southeastern direction to the beginning corner, and being the same property
conveyed to Paul J. Stokes by deed of J. O. Stokes, recorded in Deed
Book BBB, Page 67, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County."
