ALL that piece, parcel and lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, being known as LOT NO. 24 according to a Survey of Belle Meade Subdivision made by Piedmont Engineering Service and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book EE, at pages 116-117. Said lot fronts on East Dorchester Boulevard and is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of East Dorchester Boulevard at the joint front corner of Lots 23 and 24, and running along the line of Lot 23, N. 71-0 East 150 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 23 and 24; thence N. 19-0 West 75 feet to an iron pin; joint rear corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence along the line of Lot 25, S. 71-0 West 150 feet to an iron pin on East Dorchester Boulevard; joint front corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence along East Dorchester Boulevard, S. 19-0 East 75 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

Subject, however, to those protective covenants and restrictions and the easements reserved therein, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 505, at page 73. Deed Book 511, at page 513 and Deed Book 521, at page 199.
