ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a Portion of Lot No. 2 of the property of R. W. Jones according to a Survey made by W. J. Riddle, June 1947 and recorded in Plat Book U, at page 115, RMC Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on White Horse Road, said iron pin being 20 feet South of the joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2 and running thence along White Horse Road, North 3-32 West 80 feet to an iron pin; running thence North 88-02 East 200 feet to an iron pin; running thence South 3-32 East 80 feet to an iron pin; running thence a new line through Lot No. 2, South 88-20 West 200 feet to the beginning corner.
