KENNETH T. BATSON, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land in Greenville County on Razor Drive Extension, known and designated as Lot No. 9 according to a plat of the property of L. T. Chapman made by G. A. Ellis, Surveyor, on July 25, 1946, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin on Razor Drive Extension at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10, which pin is 300 feet from the intersection of Razor Drive Extension and Tindal Road, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 10 in a southerly direction 150 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence N. 68 W., 100 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence with line of Lot No. 8 in a northerly direction 148 feet to the southern side of Razor Drive Extension; thence with the southern side of Razor Drive Extension 100 feet to the beginning corner.
