"All that tract of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 45.03 acres, more or less, known as the V. L. Johnson, Sr., homeplace 45 acres, more or less, was acquired by V. L. Johnson, Sr., deceased, from the estate of his mother, Betty Johnson, being the same property acquired by her from James P. Payne as will more fully appear by reference to deed recorded in Vol. UU, at Page 674 in the RMC Office for Greenville County. Three-Hundredths of an acre was acquired by V. L. Johnson, Sr., deceased, from Mary Payne Holliday, by deed dated June 30, 1934, and recorded in Vol. 175, at Page 487 in the RMC Office for Greenville County.

ALSO: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being on the south side of Sunny Lane in Grove Township, Greenville County, S. C., lying west of the Greenville-Piedmont Road, known as U. S. Highway No. 29 and being a portion of Lot 27 on plat of property of R. E. Dalton made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, November, 1947, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, Page 15 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Sunny Lane 80.7 feet westerly from corner of Lot 28; thence S. 13-40 W. 258.7 feet to an iron pin on line of Estate of V. L. Johnson; thence along that line, N. 78-35 W. 40 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 13-40 E. 249.5 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Sunny Lane, N. 88-44 E. 41.4 feet to the beginning. This parcel of land is to be used for the purpose of a roadway. Being the same property deeded to Mary M. Johnson, et al, by R. E. Dalton on December 4, 1951, by deed recorded in Vol. 448, Page 85 in the RMC Office for Greenville County."
