

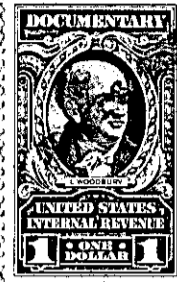
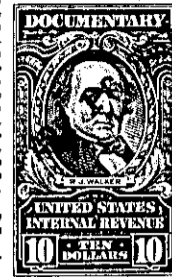

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

NEW SOUTH DEVELOPMENT CORP.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 8 as shown on a plat of the property of Greenville Airport Commission, recorded in Plat Book EE at page 193, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Tower Drive, front corner of Lot 7&8, N. 2-55 W. 208.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84-34 E. 100.1 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 9, S. 2-55 E. 213.1 feet to an iron pin on said drive; thence with said drive, S. 87-05 W. 100 feet to the beginning.

This property is subject to certain restrictions recorded in Deed Book 566 at page 547, and also a power line easement across the rear of said lot as shown on said plat.

This deed is executed pursuant to a Resolution of the Greenville Airport Commission authorizing the execution of same.
