All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, bounded by lands now or formerly owned by David Burdette, Jim Gault and others and being the old home place of the late John M. Howard and containing 168 acres more or less and the same land conveyed to A. S. Howard by deed of John T. Howard dated Oct. 1st. 1910, and recorded in office of R. H. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 9 at page 306.
