to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Grady W. Wilson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the southerly side of Gardenia Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., and being shown as Lot No. 68 on the plat of Cedar Lane Gardens as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book GG, page 139, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southerly side of Gardenia Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 68 and 69, and running thence S 20-55 E 167.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S 57-35 W 128.2 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 67 and 68; thence along the common line of said lots N 6-53 W 216.1 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of Gardenia Drive; thence along the southerly side of said Drive N 81-46 E 75 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to the 10 foot drainage easement and 5 foot utility easement as shown on the recorded plat set forth above.
