KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That I, Robert Gene Groom, a legal
resident of the City (Town) of Spokane, County of Spokane,

in the State of Washington, United States of America, now in the military

service of a Airman First Class Serial Number AF 19420711
in the Air Force of the United States, and at present being stationed
in said military service at Donaldson Air Force Base, Greenville, South
Carolina, have made, constituted and appointed and by these presents do

make, constitute and appoint Dorothy R. Groom

my true and lawful attorney to act in, manage and conduct all my estate
and all my affairs, and for that purpose for me and in my name, place,
and stead, and for my use and benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and
execute, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein
in the doing or executing of, all or any of the following acts, deeds,
and things, that is to say:

To receive and negotiate Air Force pay checks in my stead and to
utilize the funds therefrom in maintaining my household and legal
obligations.

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney full power and authority
to do and perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever
in the premises, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as
I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present; and
hereby ratify all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be
done by virtue of these presents.

And I hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder
by my said attorney shall be binding on myself, and my heirs, legal and
personal representatives and assigns; whether the same shall have been
done before or after my death or other revocation of this instrument, un-
less and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been
received by my said attorney; and whether or not I, the grantor of this
instrument, shall have been reported or listed, either officially or,
otherwise, as "missing" or "missing in action" as those words are used
in military parlance, it being the intentment hereof that such status
designation shall not bar my attorney from fully and completely exer-
cising and continuing to exercise any and all powers and rights herein
granted, and that such report of "missing" or "missing in action" shall
neither constitute nor be interpreted as constituting notice of my death
nor operate to revoke this instrument.
