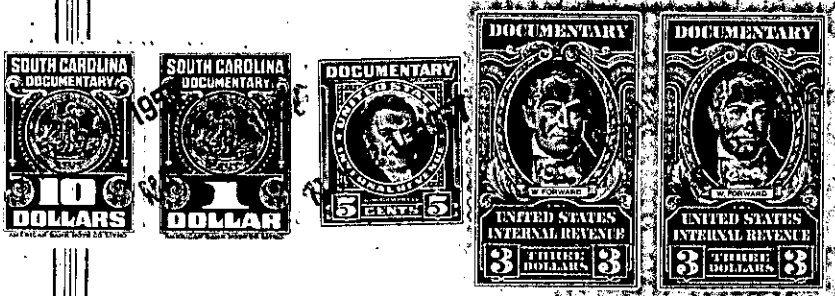
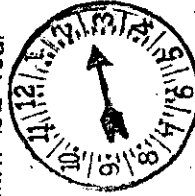

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.J. GENTRY and
MYRTLE M. GENTRY,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina:
TRACT I.

BEGINNING at a pin on Oak Grove Cemetery Lot, in Oak Grove School Dis-
trict #14A, and running thence North 1-30 West 1.86 chains to stone by
B. Gum; thence new line South 47-30 West 3.15 chains to stake by small
Hickory; thence new line North 36-13 West 19.41 chains to stone or pin
in old line on mountain; thence old line South 44 West 7.39 chains to
stone (on Old Plumley and Belue line); thence old line South 12-30 East
3.00 chains to Poplar; thence old line South 15 East 17.50 chains to
Double P.O. stump (down); thence with road North 62-15 East 4.42 chains
to pin in road. Mrs. W.M. Barnett's corner thence with her line North
1-30 West 3.09 chains to pin; thence with her line North 64.53 East
11.00 chains to BEGINNING corner; containing Nineteen and One Half (19½)
Acres more or less.

Bounded by lands of W.B. Belue, Mrs. W.M. Barnett, Colonel Lockhart,
and Plumley Estate land, Moore land on North.
