All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, beginning in a road (the Old Tugalo Road) and running N. 8-15 E. 1450 feet to a stake; thence N. 65-30 E. 1149 feet to a pin in Concord Road; thence with the road N. 0-40 E. 63 feet to a point in the road; thence with old road N. 37-50 E. 225 feet to a bend; thence N. 70-00 E. 312 feet to a stone; thence S. 16-55 E. 370 feet to L. L. Barton corner; thence S. 16-55 E. 218 feet to a Post Oak Stump; thence S. 3-30 E. 1036 feet to a road; thence S. 77-00 W. 717 feet to Clint Smith corner; thence S. 81-50 W. 570 feet to a pin near the spring; thence with the old road S. 61-15 W. 625 feet to a bend in road; thence S. 48-30 W. 161 feet to the beginning corner.
