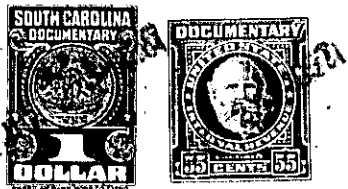

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles and Aline  
Rosemond, their heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Spring Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, designated as Lot # 5 on Plat made by J.  
Mac Richardson, February, 1950 and recorded in the R.M.C office for  
Greenville County in Plat Book # 513 at Page # 64, and according to  
said Plat having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of a county road,  
joint corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence with line of
