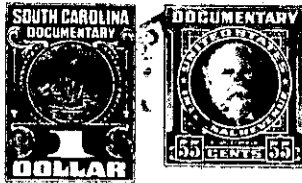

To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Eddie Sullivan

on or about the 23rd day of October in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-six exhibited his complaint in the County Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

Geneva Sullivan; Willie David Sullivan, a minor under the age of 14 years; and Paul Willis Sullivan, a minor above the age of 14 years,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th day of December 1956, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Eddie Sullivan

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. Q-2745)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$266.66

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Eddie Sullivan

All the right, title and interest of the minor Defendants, Willie David Sullivan and Paul Willis Sullivan, in and to the following described real estate:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being four parcels or tracts of land lying between the Fork Shoals Road and Reedy River, bounded by lands now or formerly belonging to W. M. Kellett on the North, Reedy River on the East, Sam F. Kellett on the south, and the Fork Shoals Road on the West, containing 118.33 acres, more or less, and having been conveyed to I. D. Sullivan, now deceased, by four deeds recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book LLL, Page 286; Book ZZZ, Page 496; Book 23 Page 328; and Book 71 Page 224; and being the identical land sold by E. Inman, Master, in the County Court, in Proceedings of I. D. Sullivan, Jr., et al, vs Missoari Sullivan Thompson, et al, and conveyed by the said E. Inman, Master, to Jeff Sullivan by deed May 29, 1953, recorded in Deed Book 472, Page 221."
