All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot Ten (10) on plat of Carver Court made by Piedmont Engineering Service, March, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I I, page 107, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Elder Street joint front corner of Lots 9 and 10 and running thence along the line of Lot 9 N. 22-25 W. 135.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 52-58 E. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60-07 E. 183.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-42 W. 95 feet to an iron pin on Elder Street; thence along Elder Street N. 76-18 W. 58.4 feet to the beginning corner.
