All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that lot of land in Greenville County and in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, in Nicholtown Heights being known and designated as Lot fifty two (52) of Section I of Nicholtown Heights as shown by a plat of W. J. Riddle made March, 1941, and recorded in Plat Book "F" at Page 6 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. This is the same property conveyed to Sallie Chapple, Corrie Thompson and John Gallman by W. T. Henderson and N. O. McDowell by deed recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Volume 257 at Page 312.

The grantor, Sallie Chapple, and Corrie Thompson, and John Gallman, acquired title to this lot as trustees for a congregation of the Pentecostal Holiness Church which was formed in Nicholtown. The deed was not drawn to show that the parties held as trustees of any Church. The congregation dissolved in about 1945. Sallie Chapple is now conveying all of her right, both individually and as a trustee, for said congregation and Church to A. J. Brown, as trustee for said Church, A. J. Brown being the Bishop of said Church
