KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That BLUE RIDGE COUNCIL, BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, quitclaimed, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, quitclaim and release unto The Cotwool Manufacturing Corporation, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware:

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, at the southwestern intersection of Third Avenue, and a 22 foot unnamed street in Judson Mill Village and being partially shown by plat of Section No. 2 of said Village prepared
