FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is THE WONDERLAND RANGE CLUB.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to hold property and to conduct social functions for the mutual benefit of the members of the organization.
