All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the southeast side of Crosby Circle, in Gantt Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 199 on plat of Paramount Park, made by Piedmont Engineering Company, July 1949, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County; S. C., in Plat Book W at page 57, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
