A certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being in *Glossy Mountain Town* *Ship Creek* *Greenville* *County* *S.C.* on waters of *Jamison's Mill Creek*, on *South* side waters of *South Branch*, Beginning on a white oak 3⁺ running Thence *N 13 1/2 E*, 31-1/4 chains to a black oak *gone* *stone*, instead 3⁺, running Thence *S 68 E*, 13-28 ch. to a *lobster* *corner* *gone*, *new* *stone* instead 3⁺, Thence *S 6 E*, 13-25 chains to a chestnut 3⁺, Thence *S 42 3/4 E*, 13-18 chains to a chestnut-oak 3⁺, Thence *S 11 1/2 E*, about 7 chains to *Jamison's Mill Creek*, Thence down the meanderings of said creek to a stone on bank of creek; Thence *N 30 1/2 E*, about 5 chains to a cross stake now a stone 3⁺; Thence *N 25 1/2 W*, 2.75 chains to the Beginning white oak corner 3⁺; supposed to contain one hundred acres be the same, more or less, *side*, Adjoining lands *D.
