 COUNTY OF GREENVILLE : SEPARATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made by and between Jeanette Tate Lynn,
 hereinafter called "The Wife", and Joe J. Lynn, hereinafter
 called "The Husband",

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS as a result of differences and disagreements, the
 parties to this agreement have heretofore separated, and since
 that time have lived separate and apart, and are of the opinion
 that it is to their advantage and welfare to live separate and
 apart in the future,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants
 and agreements herein, the parties agree:

I.

THAT the parties shall live separate and apart and each be
 free from interference, authority and control by the other, as
 fully and effectually as if he or she were sole and unmarried,
 and each may conduct, carry on, and engage in any employment,
 business or trade which to him or her shall seem advisable for
 his or her own sole or separate use and benefit, without and
 free from any control, restraint or interference, direct or in-
 direct, by the other party in all respects as if each were un-
 married.

II.

THE parties agree that they shall not molest the other or
 compel the other party to co-habit or dwell with him or her by
 any proceedings for restoration of marital rights or otherwise.

III.

THE wife agrees that she will not at any time hereafter con-
 tract any debts, charge or liability for which the husband or his
 estate shall or may be or become liable or answerable, and further
 relieves the husband of all responsibility for support of her,
 and will make no claim for support either civil or criminal.

IV.

THE wife hereby agrees to release all right of any and all
 nature, including dower rights to any property her husband now
 owns or may later acquire. The husband agrees to pay her the
