- 1 bed complete
- 1 couch and 4 chairs
- 1 typewriter
- lamps and tables (living room)

VI.

THE parties agree that each will cooperate with the other in the event that either decides to institute divorce proceedings under the law of South Carolina and will sign the necessary papers towards that end.

THE foregoing contains the entire agreement between the parties and there are no other understandings or agreements between them.
