in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Nina S. Moody, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the state of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the easterly side of Burgundy Drive, near the city of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 22 on the plat of Wildair Estates, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, at page 19, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Burgundy Drive at a point 93 feet north of the northeasterly corner of the intersection of Burgundy Drive and Edwards Road, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22, and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 76-20 E. 177.6 feet to an iron pin; thence along the common line with lot No. 38 N. 10-42 E. 100.12 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23; thence with the joint line of said lots S. 76-20 W. 132.2 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of Burgundy Drive; thence along the easterly side of Burgundy Drive S. 13-40 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner; and being the same property conveyed to me by Vernon C. Smith and Jane P. Smith by deed dated June 20, 1956 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 556, at page 9.
