JOSEPHINE E. JONES, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land located in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on Hampton Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a survey made by C. C. Jones, Civil Engineer, September 12, 1957, and designated as property of Emma E. Bates and Josephine E. Jones:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Hampton Avenue, at corner of property of Emma E. Bates, and running along Emma E. Bates' line S. 58-08 W. 140 feet; thence N. 35-15 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 58-08 E. 140 feet to an iron pin; and running thence S. 35-15 E. 75 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

This property was originally conveyed to Ernest Bates and Anna Ebaugh. The said Anna Ebaugh conveyed her one-half interest in said property to Josephine Ebaugh (now Josephine Ebaugh Jones). The said Ernest Bates died intestate in Greenville County on July 29, 1953, leaving as his sole heirs at law, Emma E. Bates, his widow and Anna Ruth Bates, his daughter.
