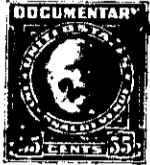

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.G. Jordan and Rosalie
B. Jordan

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, having the following courses and distances
according to survey and plat made by John C. Smith, Jr. Registered
Surveyor, dated July 27 th 1957, said plat recorded in the office of
Register of Mense Conveyance for county and State aforesaid in Vol. 00
at page 44, to wit:

Beginning at iron pin 492.5 feet from nail in center of Surface
treated road thence N-40-04-E-292.4 feet to angle, thence N-70-27-E
315 feet to iron pin, joint corner of Lenhardt Estate and grantor;
thence S-11-15-W-537 feet to I.P.; thence S-86-00W-158.5 feet to I.P.
thence N-3-55-W-249.3 feet to I.P.; thence S-80-25-W 210 feet to
beginning corner. And being bounded by lands now or formerly owned
by L.J. Meares or grantor, by Lenhardt Estate and possible others.

The above described area is composed of a portion or part of the
land conveyed to Grantor by deed of W.G. Harris dated June 29, 1957,
of record in Office of Register of Mense Conveyance for Greenville
County in Book 581 at page 203, the remainder of said tract inherit-
ed by the grantor from estate of his father A.L. MEARES in February
