

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina containing 1.09 acres, more or less, being known as parts lots nos. 6, 7 and 8 on plat of property of C. F. Putman and F. G. Mauldin recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 239 and having the following metes and bounds, towit:
Beginning at a point in the Old Hundred Road, as now located thence S 32-50 E, 13.20 chains to a point in center of Little Creek; thence wit center of creek S 84-1/2 W, 1.87 chains to a point in the center of bridge, said bridge being over Little Creek for Old Hundred Road; thence with center of road, N 24-1/2 W, 9.84 chains to iron pin in center of road; thence with center of road N 27 W, 2.53 chains to beginning corner, and bounded by lands of Coker, Old Hundred Road and Little Creek.
