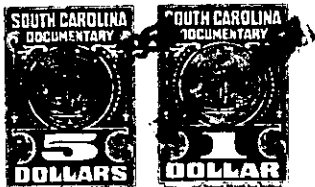

F. G. Mauldin recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in
Plat Book F at Page 239 and having the following metes and bounds, to-
