Apperson should predecease me, or for any reason become disabled or unable to serve as herein set forth, I, then, and in that event, appoint Edmond M. Apperson as substitute Attorney in Fact, and hereby vest in said substitute all power and authority herein vested in Mary McA. Apperson.
