CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, WILLIAM B. BOLT, FRANCIS McCALLUM and ROBERT H. ROSAMOND,
all of Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

WELCOME BAPTIST CHURCH
(Greenville, S.C.)

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 5th day of
November, A. D. 1957, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is WELCOME BAPTIST CHURCH

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is White Horse Road,
GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to teach and preach the gospel of Jesus Christ as set forth in the Bible in accordance with the Baptist doctrine, and to carry on the educational and religious activities of the Church.

FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

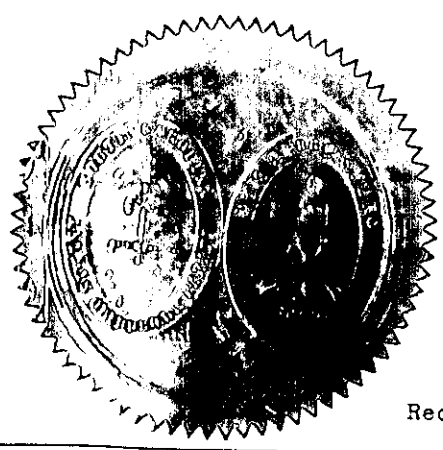

Now, I, FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the duties and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto.
